RE: ENVIRONMENT PLAN ACCEPTANCE – WOOLLYBUTT FIELD MANAGEMENT AND PLUG AND ABANDONMENT

Please be advised that the Woollybutt Field Management and Plug and Abandonment environment plan (EP), comprising:

- Woollybutt Field Management and Plug and Abandonment environment plan (Document No. 000105_DV-PR.HSE.1011.000, Revision 13, dated 23 April 2019);
- Woollybutt Oil Pollution Emergency Plan – Field Management and Plug and Abandonment (Document No. 000105_DV_PR.HSE.1045.000, Revision 3, dated 23 April 2019); and
- supplementary information provided on 10 July 2019 in response to NOPSEMA's request for further written information

has been accepted in accordance with regulation 10 of the Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage (Environment) Regulations 2009 (Environment Regulations).

An assessment of the EP was conducted in accordance with the Environment Regulations and NOPSEMA's assessment policies. This included a general assessment of the whole EP and two detailed topic assessments of the EP content, as follows:

- Matters protected under Part 3 of the EPBC Act – general assessment.
- Unplanned emissions and discharges – Adequacy of arrangements and capability for timely oil spill response to oil pollution.

This acceptance is based on the document submission(s) provided in accordance with the Environment Regulations. Please note that the responsibility for the ongoing environmental performance of the Woollybutt field management and plug and abandonment activity remains, at all times, with ENI Australia Limited.

A summary of the EP must be submitted to NOPSEMA within ten days of this notification, for public disclosure in accordance with subregulation 11(3). The required contents of an EP summary are described in subregulation 11(4). Summaries can be submitted to NOPSEMA through a secure website at <https://securefile.nopsema.gov.au/filedrop/submissions>. The summary will be published on the NOPSEMA website when NOPSEMA is satisfied with the summary.

You are reminded that in accordance with regulation 29, ENI Australia Limited must notify NOPSEMA at least ten days before commencement and within ten days after completion of any activity described in the EP.
